

## Non formal Basic Education

### A. Objective

To provide primary education to poor, drop out and over aged children.

### B. Scope of Services

NFBE project has been funded by PMLC since 1996. CCHD is currently running 240 Non-Formal Basic Education Schools in Islamabad, Lahore and Kasur. About 57,620 children have been benefited from these schools. The current strength of these schools is 8217 with 4641 girls. An important credential of these schools is provision of quality education, which is supported by the fact that Anum Saleem, a student of these NFBE schools stood first in Punjab amongst the students of NFBE schools in 2001. In 2002 the passing ratio of these schools was 79 per cent. **Students' Mobilization:** Aside from endowing students with curriculum-based education these schools tends to make them better citizens by sensitizing them about relative issues like environment, health, etc. CCHD has set up 240 Nature Clubs in NFBE schools, which run environment-management drives, actively participate in tree-plantation drives and mobilize communities on solid waste management and other environmental issues.
